



## **DAILY AND YEAR-END HIGH POINT DIVISION QUALIFICATIONS**

Exhibitors must show in at least three classes in the Division(s), except for reining, selected on the entry form, to qualify for daily high point awards. Additionally, to qualify for Year-End and Daily High Points, at least one (1) class in the Division must be ridden. For Daily and Year-End High Points, exhibitors must show the same horse (one horse/one rider). For Year-End awards, with the exception of the Sportsmanship award, exhibitors must show in 50% + one (1) show, to qualify for awards. To qualify for Year-End Awards members must also complete four (4) SFHA volunteer hours. Volunteer hours may also be purchased at \$25.00/hour in lieu of volunteer work, or a family member may complete and donate volunteer hours to the exhibitor.

*SFHA reserves the right to combine any class with 4 or fewer exhibitors. When combined classes are Hi-Point qualifiers, points will be assessed based on the exhibitors' age division.*

Grooming, Showmanship, Gaited Go As You Please, 17 & Under Gaited Pleasure

**Adult Gaited**

Grooming, Showmanship, Gaited Go As You Please, Open Gaited Pleasure

**Over Fences – May earn points in classes at two contiguous heights only**

- 18" Cross Rails, 18" Cross Rail Equitation, Low Hunter and Low Equitation Over Fences **OR**
- Low Hunter, Low Equitation Over Fences, Intermediate Hunter and Intermediate Equitation Over Fences **OR**
- Intermediate Hunter, Intermediate Equitation Over Fences, Working Hunter and Working Equitation Over Fences  
*In the event of a tie, the exhibitor with the highest equitation points will win*

**14-17 W/J Western**

14-17 Grooming, 14-17 Showmanship, 14-17 W/J Western Pleasure, 14-17 W/J Horsemanship (rail and pattern), 14-17 W/J Trail

**Adult W/J Western**

In addition to High-Point Division Awards SFHA also offers the following awards:

### **Daily Sportsmanship Award**

Members or volunteers observed being “good sports” may be anonymously nominated by the Membership for the daily sportsmanship award. The SFHA Board of Directors will select the daily winner of this special award from the nominations. Nominees do not need to be exhibiting a horse to qualify for this award.

### **Year-End Award Sportsmanship Award**

The Sportsmanship Year-End Award winner will be selected by ballot, by the SFHA Board of Directors, from the Daily Sportsmanship Award winners. Nominees do not need to be exhibiting a horse to qualify for this award.

### **Year-End In-Hand Award**

The In-Hand Award is given to the exhibitor (same horse/same exhibitor combination) with the highest year-end compilation of points from Grooming, Showmanship, and Halter classes. Exhibitors must compete in 50% + 1 shows.

### **Year-End All Around Award**

The All Around prize is awarded to the exhibitor (same horse/same rider combination) with the highest year-end cumulative points that competes in 50% + 1 shows in both English and Western classes as follows:

- Gaited Equitation, Saddleseat/ English Equitation, or Hunt Seat Equitation AND
- Gaited Pleasure, Saddle Seat/English Pleasure or Hunter Under Saddle AND
- Horsemanship AND
- Western Pleasure
